Don Larsen is putting together a "perfect night."

Larsen, who pitched the only perfect game in World Series history when the New York Yankees beat the Brooklyn Dodgers 2-0 in 1956, is aiming to bring together all living pitchers who have thrown a perfect game for a charity event Nov. 4.

"We're hoping to have good participation," Larsen said. "All the proceeds will go to several charities, the main one being ALS."

If Larsen and the organizers are successful, 11 pitchers, including Larsen, will attend: Jim Bunning (1964), Sandy Koufax (1965), Len Barker (1981), Mike Witt (1984), Tom Browning (1988), Dennis Martinez (1991), Kenny Rogers (1994), David Wells (1998), David Cone (1999) and Randy Johnson (2004).
